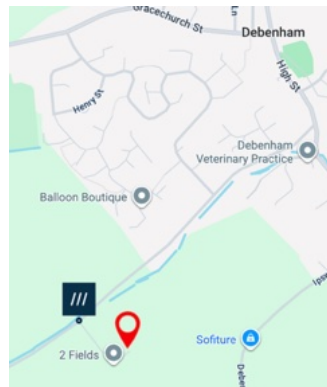


Contacting us

Debenham Shed is a place where members use our large collection of tools and source material to make things; by themselves, with guidance, or with others. It is also for social connecting and friendship building, sharing skills and knowledge, and of course a lot of laughter.

Good health and well-being matters!



For a long time, research has shown the negative impact of loneliness and isolation on a person's health and well-being.

Men typically find it more difficult to build social connections than women. Men's sheds reduce isolation and renew a sense of purpose while providing the opportunity to use your skills and learn more. Hence the term men's shed. Started in Australia, there are now more than 1,000 registered UK men's sheds and growing.



Our Workshops and Tools



Debenham Shed is housed in four shipping containers located at the 2 Fields Community Supported Farm on Low Road. Whatever your interest we would like to say we have the tools for the job, and if we do not then we are willing to learn and provide the means. Our site has the following facilities;

Main Shed area, this is a low noise and low risk area for craft activities and the Galley and Store areas.

Front enclosed cloister benches and car port, used for work requiring ventilation (sanding, painting, wood filing etc.) and a concrete base for safe jacking up of cars needing repair.

West Wing, our higher risk area where power tools operate (lathes, pillar drills etc.) and is only used by trained members.

Welding Shed, for trained and those in training to use our welding facilities also used for hot work such as angle grinding. Has ventilation and welding curtains.

North Wing, our new area for metal bashing and higher risk working.

Other Sheds, these are used for Painting and Storage of COSSH items (oil base paints etc.) and Sand Blasting.
